- Applicants are required to submit a CD recording demonstrating their playing or a written recommendation from their music teacher.
- All applicants must also submit a completed application form and a non-refundable application fee of \$100 (USD), which will be deducted from the total program fee upon acceptance.
- Application fees must be paid by check or money order and made payable to American Fine Arts Festival. The deadline for receipt of completed applications is January 26, 2009.

FEES & PAYMENT SCHEDULE

Application Fee: \$100 The application fee is nonrefundable and will be deducted from the total program fee. Applications must be received by January 26, 2009.

Deposit: \$200 Confirmation and a non-refundable deposit are due by February 10, 2009, with the remaining balance due by February 26, 2009.

Total Program Fees

Double Room: **\$2,400** (\$2,300 for participants of the 2008-2009 AFAF)

The program fees covers tuition, room & board during our stay in Weimar, official festival activities, as well as transportation to and accommodations in Nuremberg, Munich, Salzburg, Vienna. (Please note that the program fee does not cover the cost of excursions to Halle, Zwickau and Leipzig and it does not cover any miscellaneous expenses, such as entrance fees to museums, etc.)

- The AFAF can provide accommodations for those parents or family members who wish to accompany participants for the duration of the program. The cost of room & board for parents/guardians is \$1,400 per person. Please call or visit our website for more information.
- Masterclasses will be offered to winners of an on-site competition free of charge. Other participants will be able to attend masterclasses for an additional fee of \$100.
- Due to extensive pre-arrangements that have to be made in order to ensure the success of this program, no refunds will be provided for cancellations made after April 15, 2009.
